
WARDROBE

• **STREET PARKING:** We have parking reserved along 990 Maine Ave., SW - Washington, DC right outside the same side of the street as the Artist Entrance for The Anthem. There are limited spaces, but we should be able to accommodate 8 vehicles for the Mosaic Harmony Group, if you park as close together as possible without impeding each other's entry/exit.




• GARAGE PARKING: Parking at District Wharf is <u>VERY LIMITED</u>. Please make note of which garage you enter and where you park your vehicle once inside the District Wharf Parking garage. Please see the following map to indicate where you can park in tandem (see Section B1 circled in red below). There's an attendant, who can facilitate your parking in one of these spaces. Note: if you're in the front of the tandem space, where you park in front of another car, you will give your key to the attendant in case, whomever is behind you comes and needs to exit the garage.



• We will be covering the parking fee for 8 vehicles. I'll provide Mosaic Harmony with 8 chaser tickets to pay for parking, if they don't park on the street. You will need to pull a ticket when you park in the garage and keep that ticket to use when you exit along with the chaser ticket that I give you. When exiting the garage, you'll insert your parking ticket first and then the chaser ticket in order to exit.

- Once you have parked in the garage, follow the Freedom Forum logo signs to the District Pier (C2) Section of the Garage
- Take the elevator to the Pier/Street Level and turn right as you exit the elevator



• Walk towards Maine Ave, SW, and make a left, then walk a few steps until you see The Anthem Artists' Entrance on your left, located at 990 Maine Ave., SW (see photo below):

 A talent escort will greet your group upon arrival, provide you with wristbands for backstage access, and escort you backstage to standby for rehearsal/soundcheck; After rehearsal, your group will be escorted to Tour Catering to get a meal and then your group will be escorted to your dressing room to standby until it's time to be called to standby to go onstage and perform.
