In preparation for the June 23 concert, your concert planning team has compiled a list of FAQs and the answers. We strongly recommend having this list and to review the members only section of the website for more information not covered here.

Q: What's the call time for choir members on Sunday?	A: Choir arrival for Schlesinger is 3:00pm. It is very important that you are in place as we will be doing sound check and final production prep. We will review the three songs that our alumni are joining us to perform.
Q: What about parking once there? Is there handicapped parking?	A: Parking is FREE! There is a map attached for your convenience to show where to park. There is adequate handicapped parking available as well.
Q: Will we be able to have water on stage?	A: No , however, we would encourage everyone to hydrate as much as possible in the days before and also before we go on stage.
Q: Will there be water/snacks in the green room?	A: We are awaiting the response from Schlesinger, but we are assuming this will not be a problem. There will be miniature bottles of water and fruit in the green room. Please limit bringing snacks that require clean up.
Q: Will we be seated when we are not singing?	A: Yes, this is not any different from previous concerts. We have seated risers.
Q: What's the deal with the Happy Hour at Clyde's	A: Remember to join us on Saturday from 3-6pm at Clyde's - 1701 N Beauregard Street, Alexandria VA 22311 - The 3-6pm time is the regular happy hour for the restaurant and the drinks and appetizers are at a reduced price. It is possible to make a reservation for dinner (strongly recommended). All food and beverage are on your own dime.
Q: How are we paying for this concert? Won't we lose money because of the venue cost?	A: The venue has already been paid for with targeted donations. Production costs were covered once we sold 76 tickets. Because ticket sales continue to rise, we are making money on this concert.
Q: Are we wearing anything different than Concert Dress?	A: We are wearing standard concert dress. If you need a refresher on what that is, check our guidelines in the members only section only of the website, on the Sign-up Genius page or in Choir Notes.
Q: Are there going to be hard copy programs or a handout on concert day?	A: No - the program will be only digital.
Q: How many tickets have been sold?	A: Almost 150! However, you have been amazing in sharing the poster on social media! Keep it up and don't stop!
